Nursery & Mixed-Age Kindergarten Garden Nest

The children enjoy the afternoon in the nursery or in one of the mixed-age kindergarten classrooms. Lunch is provided by parents (homemade soup is only provided to the nursery). The daily rhythm includes a nap or rest time, followed by both indoor and outdoor free-play. The program is led by experienced early childhood teachers.

- \$4,250 for the 5-day/full year
- \$3,400 for the 4-day/full year
- \$2,550 for the 3-day/full year

Extended Day Programs

3:00 pm - 6:00 pm

Nursery - Grade 3

After a long school day, our goal is to provide a nurturing and home-like atmosphere for children who stay for the Extended Day Program. Children in nursery and kindergarten gather in one of the mixed-age kindergarten classrooms, while the first, second and third graders gather in a classroom. The program includes both indoor and outdoor play, as weather permits. A healthy mid-afternoon snack is provided.

- \$15 per hour, \$7.50 for additional siblings

Grades 4 - 8

After a nutritious snack, and maybe even a bit of physical activity, students work quietly in the Library. Assistance is provided by teachers, as well as selected college and high school students, as needed. Children without assignments, or who have completed their work, are supervised during indoor and outdoor play, which sometimes includes cheering on the Waldorf sports teams!

Tutoring & Supervision

3:20 pm - 6:00 pm

Grades 9 - 12

If high school students need assistance organizing their main lesson books or require support in a daily subject, such as math or science, calculus or physics, the **High School Program Coordinator** will schedule and arrange individual tutoring services.

For specialized tutoring, hourly fees apply and vary depending upon the number of students being tutored, as well as the level of skill offered by the tutor.

High School Student Supervision

All students remaining on campus after 3:20pm must be enrolled in a supervised after school activity. Students are also offered quiet supervised spaces in which to do their homework. Homework help is available.

In order for students to leave school grounds to purchase food before returning to their after school activity, we require parental permission. During the time when students are not on school grounds, we cannot take responsibility for either the students or their actions.
